RESULTS OF ELECTION OF STAFF GOVERNORS 2010

Academic Staff Governor

A Staff Governor elected by and from Academic Staff

Elected: Dr Sascha Bachmann, Senior Lecturer, School of Law

First term of office: 1 August 2010 – 31 July 2012

Process

Three candidates stood for election.

1058 Ballot papers were issued.

182 Votes were received: 17.2%

(Votes received in previous years: June 2002: uncontested; June 2004: 180; June 2006: 205, June 2008: 173; June 2009: 222.)

Valid papers counted 182

Quota = 50% + 1 of valid counted papers = 91 + 1 = 92

An alternative transferable vote system was used. The details of the breakdown of votes at each stage are recorded in the table below. In brief:

- Michele-Anne Dauppe was eliminated first with 47 votes;
- Following transfer of votes, (10 expressed no next preference) Paul Norman was eliminated with 84 votes;
- At the end of the counting process, although no candidate had reached the quota, Sascha Bachmann had achieved the highest number of votes.

Elected: Mrs Riz McNaught, Principal Administrator, Academic Registry

Second term of office: 1 August 2010 – 31 July 2012

Process

Two candidates stood for election.

1362 Ballot papers were issued.

424 Votes were received: 31.1%

(Votes received in previous years: June 2002: 360; June 2004: 351; June 2006: uncontested; June 2008: 412.)

Claire Brookes 175 votes cast

Riz McNaught 248 votes cast

(one ballot paper was spoilt)
