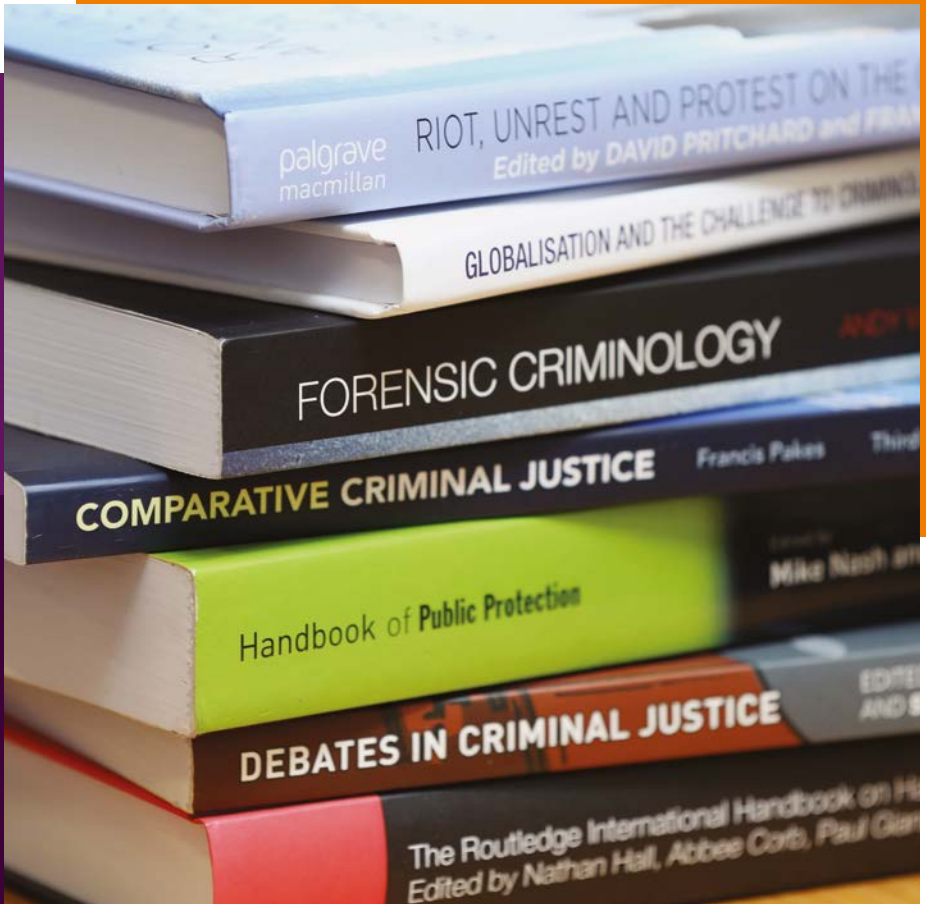

Undergraduate distance learning degrees

## BSc (Hons) **Counter Fraud and Criminal Justice Studies**

Example topics covered:

- Types and dimensions of fraud; internet fraud, corporate fraud, 'scams', 'crash for cash', date fraud, international fraud
- Counter-fraud strategies; target hardening, internet security, fraud investigation and intelligence

## BSc (Hons) **Crime and Criminology**

Example topics covered:

- The measurement of crime and crime patterns
- The major causes of crime
- The agencies responsible for controlling crime; police, courts and prisons
- The victims of crime

## BSc (Hons) **Policing and Investigation**

Example topics covered:

- Differing policing styles; who polices the police?
- Police leadership; principles and models of criminal investigation
- The sources of intelligence; covert policing, surveillance, counter terrorism

## BSc (Hons) **Risk and Security Management**

Example topics covered:

- Understanding and managing risk
- Definitions of security and its dimensions; internet and information security
- Financial security; global security and counter-terrorism

- **Virtual learning:** our virtual learning environment provides access to course materials, and communication channels with tutors and other students.
