





Accepting an offer to study here is simple.

Accepting your offers in UCAS Hub

Before you confirm your decision in UCAS Hub, you need to wait for all the universities you chose to get back to you.

If you applied by the UCAS deadline (25 January 2023), all universities will get back to you with a decision by May. You'll see decisions for each of your choices in UCAS Hub.

You can then:

Select 1 course as your firm (first) choice.
Select 1 course as your insurance (back up) choice.

You then need to:

Decline any other offers. You can decline all offers if you want. This needs to be done by 8 June 2023 (if you receive the final decision on or before 18 March 2023)

Changing your mind

If you change your mind about your firm or insurance choice, you can make changes within 14 days of accepting it by contacting UCAS. After that, you'll need to contact us. You can do this up until 21 July.
